Personal Property Taxes

Tax is levied on business furnishings and equipment based on information provided to the Assessor of Property. You must notify the Assessor of Property and the County Clerk when you sell or close your business. Personal Property taxes are owed if the business was in operation on January 1, 2016.

- A total and permanent disability rating

Important Dates

December 31, 2016: Return all applications and vouchers for faster processing.

February 28, 2017: Pay your portion of 2016 property taxes to avoid interest and penalty.

April 5, 2017: Submit all applications, vouchers, and payments to receive tax benefits.

Income Limit* of \$38,360

The Tax Freeze Program was created to help seniors by freezing the tax amount on their primary residence for future years.



You may qualify for the Tax Freeze if:

- Age 65 or older, and
- Own and live in a home in Shelby County that is your primary residence (mobile homes included), and
- Combined 2015 income for you, your spouse* and all other owners is \$38,360 or less

**Legislation requires the income of the applicant's spouse to be included, regardless of ownership.*

How does the Tax Freeze benefit you?

If you are a new applicant this year, the Tax Freeze Program freezes the 2017 tax amount on residential property taxes based on the tax amount from 2016.

If you have previously been approved for Tax Freeze, you must reapply every year to keep your taxes at the frozen amount.

Quarterly Payment Plan

Who qualifies?

- Age 65 or older
- Fixed income (SSI, SSA, Pension)
- Own and live in a home in Shelby County that is your primary residence
- Taxes must be paid on prior years
- Submit applications by October 31, 2016
- Quarterly payments are due October 2016 and January, April and July 2017.

All applications are subject to approval

Wheel Tax

The Shelby County Trustee processes Wheel Tax rebates for eligible seniors and qualified disabled residents. This \$50 annual benefit is a reimbursement of the wheel tax.

Who qualifies?

- Age 65 or older, or
- A total and permanent disability rating, and
- Annual household income—\$25,000 or less

Documentation required:

- Completed Wheel Tax Rebate application (available at www.shelbycountystatetrustee.com or County Clerk and Trustee locations)
- Copy of paid vehicle registration for current year
- Proof of age (copy of valid driver's license or birth certificate)
- Proof of income (copy of Social Security Benefits Statement or most recent federal tax return)
- Copy of paid vehicle registration for handicap license plate (not hang tag) for disabled drivers for current year
